DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

The Educational Enrichment for Young Patriots, INC., is a 501(c)3 nonprofit corporation and a valuable partner in the augmentation of Virginia public school education K-12, to develop next generation leaders emphasizing history and social sciences (civics). All payments made to the organization for this program will go directly to underwrite the program itself. We welcome parents or quardians to participate at any level, or to simply observe the program. The program is intended to be a FUN activity for students to learn about responsibility, camaraderie, leadership, and the nuances of military life. The goal of the Bear Chase Boot Camp is to build the stamina, confidence, and leadership skills of participating cadets. They will learn the fundamentals of team building, personal accountability and responsibility while striving for excellence. The "Daily 7" exercises are intended to strengthen the stamina and physical fitness of cadets, which they can do on their own, with no group "minimum" standard. Each cadet works to his or her best level of performance. As cadets are introduced to leadership traits, they will be able to apply the same principles to making important decisions hereafter in elementary, middle, and high school, which will shape their future. No cadet will be singled out for any reason aside from praise for a task well done. There will be no hazing or harsh treatment that can be associated with actual military basic training. There will be at least two DIs present at any time, to isolate and mitigate any disruptions.

Cadets should wear comfortable clothing appropriate for physical fitness training and formation runs. At the end of the second day, they will earn their T-Shirts and caps.
